English for Law

A strong command of English is a critical skill for legal professionals working in the international arena.

UNSW Institute of Languages offers English for Law, an interactive 5–20 week course designed to give students the experience and the written and spoken English skills necessary to communicate effectively with clients and professionals in a legal environment. It also provides the preparation needed to successfully sit the International Legal English Certificate (ILEC) exam.

Who should take the Course?

English for Law is designed for Upper Intermediate to Advanced students with an interest in Commercial Law.

The course is ideally suited for students approaching the end of their degree programs, law graduates or for legal professionals seeking to improve their English proficiency.

The course focuses on improving students' ability to function in an English speaking commercial law environment and also prepares students for the ILEC Exam, covering the four (4) skill areas of speaking, listening, writing and reading.

Content covered includes:

- ◆ Legal vocabulary
- ◆ Interpreting and understanding legal texts
- ◆ Writing legal letters and memoranda
- ◆ Understanding and participating in discussions on legal topics
- ◆ Explaining aspects of law

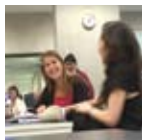
In addition, students participate in excursions to local law courts, Parliament and law firms. Interested students will be referred to an agency to help arrange a legal internship (IELTS 5.5 or equivalent is required).

Assessment tasks include a presentation, letter and memo writing and in-class tests of reading, vocabulary and listening.
