What the TESOL course offers you

The UNSW Institute of Languages TESOL Certificate offers a unique combination of theory and practice. You will gain an insight into underlying theories and new methodologies of language learning/teaching. You will also learn a range of practical skills for teaching English to adult learners.

The course is delivered in a mixture of lecture style sessions and practical workshops/activities and includes hands-on teaching practice.

TESOL graduates from UNSW Institute of Languages have been successful in gaining teaching positions in both public and private sector educational institutions in Australia and overseas.

The TESOL Certificate is available as a part-time evening course over 20 weeks or a full-time intensive course run in January each year.

You will be required to demonstrate an excellent level of proficiency in both written and spoken English to complete your enrolment. This will be measured through an interview and language awareness task before you commence your study.

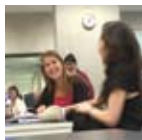

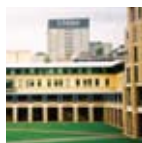
The Institute of Languages is only a short bus trip from Sydney's central business district and five minutes from some of the city's most beautiful parks and beaches.
